Please park in the small parking lot on the right next to the Financial Literacy Center and the Computer Lab. Blaine Wiles will be there to greet you!

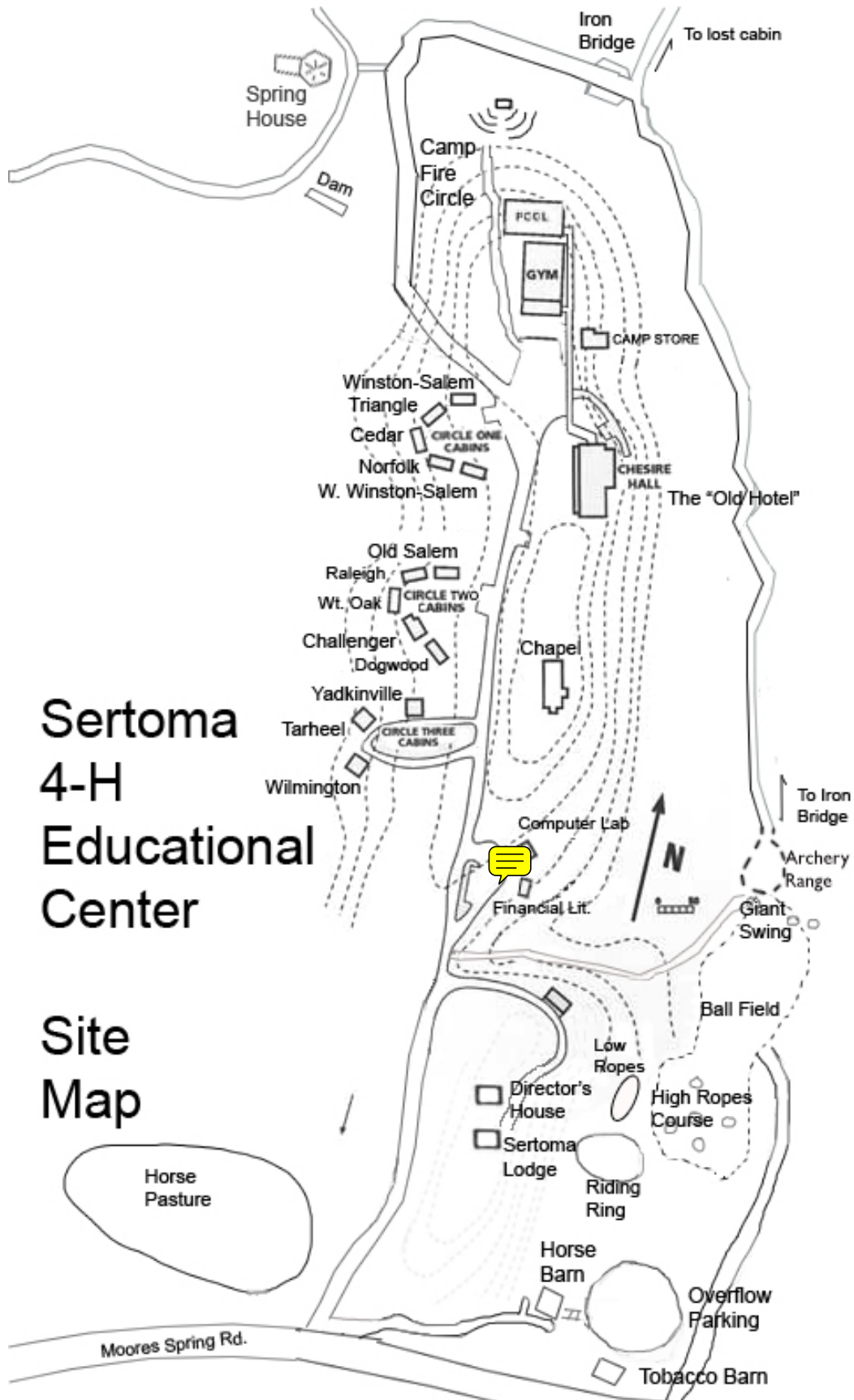
### Directions

Google Maps, MapQuest and Yahoo Maps will give you directions. Most GPS devices recognize the address and will give you good directions to the site. The directions below are different than those that will come up on the internet/GPS. That's okay – either works!

- Take I-40 and drive towards Winston-Salem
- In Winston-Salem, I-40 will intersect with Hwy. 52
- Take 52 North towards Mt. Airy. Pass the University Parkway Exit, Pass the Rural Hall Exit.
- After 10 - 15 minutes on 52 you will take the RJR-Moore Rd. exit
- At the top of the ramp, take a left.
- At the 4th stop, that includes stoplights and stop signs mind you, take a left onto Hwy. 66 North
- In about 12 minutes you will get to Moores Springs Road - take that right
- The Sertoma 4-H Educational Center, located at Historic Vade Mecum Springs, will be on your left in 3 minutes.
